HOW TO REACH THE CITY

1. From Arlanda airport

Take the shuttle train Arlanda Express, which will take you directly to the central station in 20 minutes. 360 SEK two-way ticket.

Should you prefer bus, the ride costs 190 SEK two-way ticket, takes 45 minutes.

A taxi takes about 40 minutes and costs 400 SEK.

2. From Bromma airport

There is an airport shuttle that ends up at the Central station.

Should you prefer ordinary bus, it includes a shift to metro at Alvik.
